Army and had Serial No. RA 15255161; 22 years of age, born July 25, 1928; white; five feet eight inches; one sixty-five lbs.; medium build; fair complexion; brown hair, crew cut; blue eyes; scars - diagonal scar on right elbow; dress - when last seen was wearing the full dress uniform of the U. S. Military Academy Cadet.

As a cooperative measure, the letter from Captain GUIDERA requests that in the event the Bureau secures any information concerning this missing. person that the office of the Provost Marshal, Headquarters First Army, Governors Island, New York, New York, Attention CID, be informed.
